The University of Public Health (Yangon) is a government university, under the Department of Human Resource for Health, Ministry of Health and Sports. The University was established in July 2007 with the purpose of the pursuit of population health in the service of society. The role of the University of Public Health (Yangon) is to develop leaders and managers in the health sector by: (a) educating health and health-related personnel, (b) conducting quality research and (c) participating in the practice of health care services. The University has nine departments: Health Policy and Management, Epidemiology, Biostatistics and Medical Demography, Occupational and Environmental Health, Health Behaviour and Communication, Population and Family Health, Medical Education Science and ICT, Nutrition and Food Safety, and Public Health Laboratory Science. The University offers a Ph.D. in Public Health; a Master of Public Health; a Master of Hospital Administration; a Diploma in Medical Education; and an e-learning program for public health professionals.
